Bachelor of Arts in Innovation in Society

This degree is best suited to students inclined towards humanities, qualitative social sciences and related fields. BA students need to complete a foreign language requirement.

Bachelor of Science in Innovation in Society

In the BS program, you will learn the tools you need to analyze new technologies and innovations and how they may or may not benefit society. You will be prepared to develop innovative strategies to link the needs and values of society to new innovation to build exciting futures. This degree is best suited to students inclined towards natural sciences, economics, engineering and quantitative social sciences. BS students take an extra set of science, engineering, and/or math courses beyond the university requirements.

Minor in Innovation in Society

Regardless of what major you are in, science and technology will probably impact your work. As a minor in the innovation for society program, you will learn how new and emerging technologies can connect with the social needs and values of our communities to provide the best local and global futures. The minor can be completed in as few as 15 credit hours.

Innovation for Impact Certificate

You will get the tools and learn the concepts to synthesize research from varied disciplines across campus as well as across the globe. You will identify a problem and work with peers, mentors, and the community to produce innovation that cultivates a better future for society.
